



Bay To The Beach

Starting on the Chesapeake Bay In Crisfield Maryland, and ending in Ocean City Maryland on the Atlantic Ocean. This is a fun drive on winding back roads of approximately 60 miles that should only take a few hours to complete. More time should be allowed for a side trip to Furnace Town, and for lunch and shopping in Berlin.



Crisfield Maryland is located on the Chesapeake Bay, off of Tangier Sound near the mouth of the Annessex River. Crisfield is known world wide for their delicious seafood.

The drive starts at the dock in Crisfield heading East on route 413.

Turn right onto route 667, (Crisfield Marion Rd.) continue straight through intersection with Tullis Corner Rd.

Route 667 changes to Hudson Corner Rd.

Through Marion Station

Route 667 turns right onto Rehobeth Rd.

Through Frogeye

At intersection with route 13, (Ocean Hwy.) turn right onto Ocean Hwy.

At stoplight turn left onto route 364, (Dividing Creek Rd.) will change to Nassawango Rd.

Pocomoke River State Park will be on the right.

Through Corbin

For the side trip to Furnace Town.

Turn left onto Creek Rd. (This is nearly a hidden entrance that can easily be missed, it is on the left just as Nassawango Rd. goes to the right.)

Left at intersection with Red House Rd

Right at intersection with Sand Rd onto

Millville Rd to Furnace Town

Return in reverse or go right on Furnace Rd.

Right onto route 12 (Snow Hill Rd.)

Left onto route 354 Whiton Rd

Furnace Town Village brings to life the daily life activities of this 19th century industrial village. This Living Heritage Museum highlights from 1828 to 1850, when



miners, sawyers, molders and firemen, carters, draymen and bargemen gathered.

Continue on Nassawango Rd.

At intersection with route 12 (Snow Hill Rd.) cross over route 12 onto route 354, Whiton Rd.

Through Indiantown, Through Whiton

Route 354 changes to Powelville Rd.

Right onto route 374, Burbage Crossing Rd. changes to Libertytown Rd., Through Libertytown,

Through Timmostown

Route 374 changes to Broad St. when arriving in Berlin.



In the early 1900s, Berlin was known as a pleasant rest stop for travelers on their way to the small coastal village of [Ocean City MD](#). At one time, it boasted more overnight accommodations than Ocean City. www.berlinmd.com

Leaving Berlin go east on route 374, (Bay st.) which changes to route 376.

Route 376 crosses route 113, changes to Assateague Rd. Left onto Sinepuxent Rd.

At intersection with route 611, (Stephen Decatur Hwy.) turn left onto Stephen Decatur Hwy.

At intersection with route 50, (Ocean Gtwy.) turn right onto Ocean Gtwy. over the bridge and into Ocean City.

Right onto Philadelphia Ave. (one way) will take you to the inlet parking and easy access to the Boardwalk.

Or go straight, then left onto Baltimore Ave. (one way) will take you north. After 9th St. you can take a left to get over to Philadelphia Ave. which will be two way traffic now.
